

GUIDELINES FOR EXTENDED/LUXURY FIT

WHY PD IS NOT ALWAYS THE ANSWER TO A PERFECT FIT

Pupil distance (PD) is not a perfect indicator of head size, but most of the time if you have a big PD then you are probably going to need big glasses. Likewise, if you have a small PD, you're probably going to need small glasses. Keep in mind that it's not an exact science when it comes to PD predicting fit.




The PD of an AVERAGE ADULT MALE tends to be in the mid 60's




the PD of an AVERAGE ADULT FEMALE tends to be in the high 50's to low 60's

EXTENDED & LUXURY FIT EYEWEAR USUALLY FALL ALONG THESE RANGES OF PDs:



Men
EXTENDED FIT 65mm +



Women LUXURY FIT 63mm +

WHAT DETERMINES IF A FRAME IS EXTENDED (MEN) OR LUXURY (WOMEN) FIT

Zyloware determines if a frame is EXTENDED or LUXURY FIT with two simple guidelines:



Adding the eye and the bridge size together and subtracting 8mm (proper fit) and then check the PD.

example Men's Frame Eye Size: 55/18
Formula: 55 + 18 = 73mm

73 - 8 = 65 mm PD

According to the guidelines listed above, this frame would qualify for EXTENDED FIT.

ANOTHER WAY THAT ZYLOWARE DETERMINES EXTENDED OR LUXURY FIT ON EYEGLASSES IS THE END PIECE

Zyloware has extended the end pieces on smaller eye sizes for the person with a narrow PD to accommodate extra room in the headspace to qualify for EXTENDED/LUXURY FIT.
